How to install the B&G Flash Download software to your PC

Software Installation

- 1) Ensure that no other applications are running.
- 2) Insert the B&G Field Programmer Utility CD into your computer CD Drive.
- 3) The CD should automatically start the installation process after a few seconds. If the Autorun option does not start to load the program, double click **My Computer** from the desk top menu. Now double click the CD ROM drive icon, this should reveal a list of files, double click on the file **Setup.exe** to start the installation process.
- 4) The installation process will now start, and the screen should display 'Welcome to B&G Flash Download'. Click **OK** to carry on the installation.
- 5) The Installation program will now show the folder location where the program will be installed. This is normally **C:\Program Files\B&G Flash Download**. This may be changed, but it must be noted, as this will be the folder in which the update files (.UPD) are stored. To carry on with the installation click on the square button containing the program **setup** icon.
- 6) The installation program will now check that the computer has enough disk space and then display the name of the program group that will be created. This is normally **B&G Flash Download**. Click **OK** to continue, or you may change the name if required, and then click **OK** to copy the files to your hard drive.
- 7) The necessary files are now copied from the CD to the hard drive, and the CD can be removed from your computer.

To start B&G Flash Download Click **Start** on the task bar, select **Programs** then B&G Flash Download.

Note: There is no need to set up the COM port as B&G Flash Download will automatically detect the Field Programmer.

How and where to obtain the system upgrade files

Location

The update files (.UPD), are obtainable from the B&G website at www.BandG.com

Scroll to the bottom of the B&G homepage and double click on **technet** follow the link to the menu page.

Enter your User Name and Pass Code (only available to authorized B&G dealers/distributors), this will allow access to the software update files.

Copy the relevant upgrade file(s) from the website into the Flash Download directory (e.g. **C:\Program Files\B&G Flash Download**) on your PC.

System connections

connections

System components share data together via a common Fastnet² databus, therefore in order to up-grade the software to an individual instrument, it must be disconnected from the Fastnet²databus.

Connect the field programmer device (FPD) to the instrument as follows:

The FastNet² cable from the disconnected instrument should be attached to the POWER IN connector on the field programming device.

The Grey PC cable should be connected to the spare com. port on your computer.

The Yellow INSTRUMENT cable should be connected to the instrument requiring the software upgrade.

Refer to the diagram on Page 6 of this manual.

Using the Flash Download software

With the instrument connected to your PC via the field programmer device, see the diagram on Page 7 of this manual, activate the B&G Flash Download Utility. The screen will display three options as follows:

Map

Selecting this option, the program will scan the connected system to identify the instrument(s) connected and their respective software versions.

Update

Selecting this option, the program will confirm the unit connected and its current version. The utility offers the option to upgrade to a defined version, by selecting the **YES** option, the screen will display a warning panel advising 'Note The SerialNo.' of the unit to be upgraded.

Note: If, for whatever reason, the upgrade fails, this serial number must be used, when prompted, to re-activate the instrument.

Having noted the serial No., clicking on the **OK** option will begin the program download. The screen will now display the download information with an animated progress bar to indicate status.

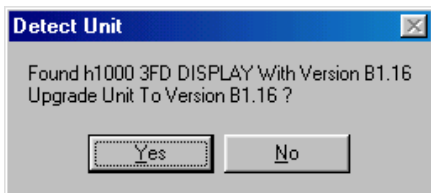
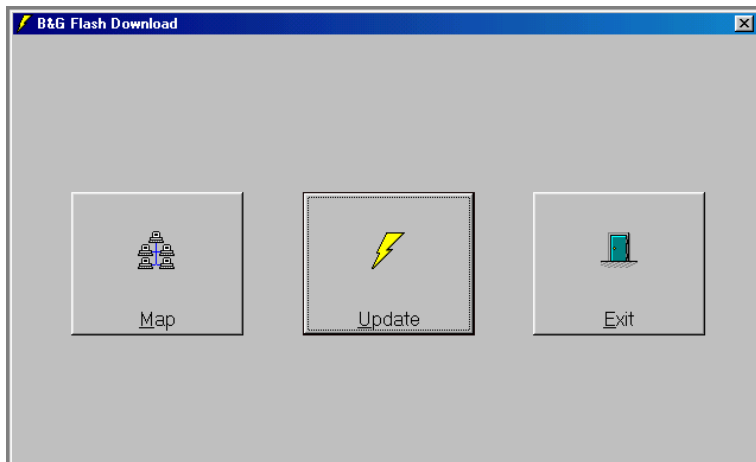
Once the download is complete, the user will be prompted to confirm the download. Clicking the cursor on the **OK** option returns the user to the main screen.

Exit

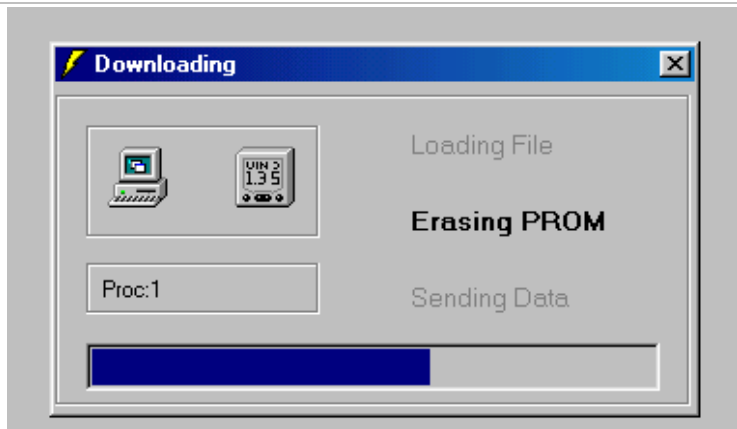
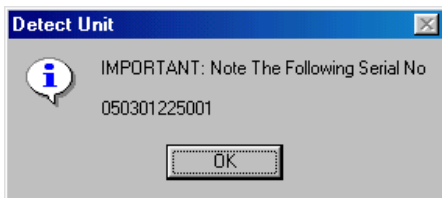
Closes the Flash Download Utility.

Note: The following 'screen shots' show a typical example only, unit types and software versions vary.

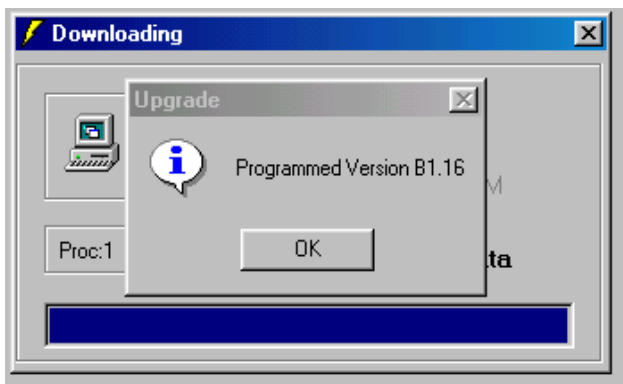
Using the Flashdownload software – Screen shots



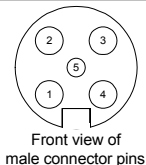
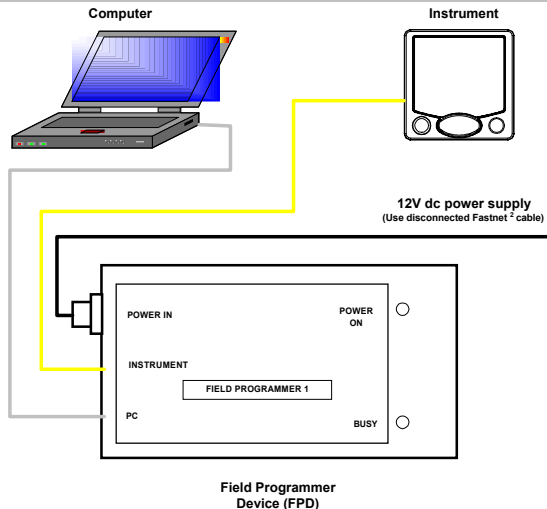

Electrical connections



External connections

The unit has two permanently connected cables, one grey; interface between PC and Unit, one Yellow; interface between Unit and Instrument the third connection is for a 12volt power supply via the FastNet² databus.

The table below shows the FastNet² pin functions.
